BILLING

If you choose to enroll in our Contract Maintenance Program, we will send you an invoice at the beginning of each month. The invoice will be due on the 10th of the following month. The first monthly payment is due when you sign the Agreement.

MILEAGE CHARGE

Should you go over the allotted miles per year (see above), you will be invoiced for an overage charge at \$.05 cent per mile annually. Average miles per year will be reviewed and adjusted, if needed, in January of each year.

PM SERVICES

FMI's computer system will track your vehicle usage and we will call you when it's time for a service. FMI will service and inspect your vehicle as outlined on the attached *Preventive Maintenance Program Summary*. We will use factory trained technicians, OEM filters and assure that your vehicle is serviced at the intervals recommended by the factory.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM SUMMARY

- **The Preventive Maintenance Interval is based on the manufacturers recommendation specific to the year, make and model of the vehicle.**
- Change engine oil, oil filters and fuel filters.
- Check condition of automatic transmission fluid. Adjust fluid level if required. Check for leaks.
- Service automatic transmission at manufacturers recommended interval.
- Check condition of manual transmission fluid. Adjust fluid level if required. Check for leaks.
- Service manual transmission at manufacturers recommended interval.
- Check condition of differential fluid. Adjust fluid level if required. Check for leaks.
- Service differential at the manufacturers recommended interval.
- Check and fill hydraulic clutch reservoir (if applicable).
- Check and fill hydraulic brake fluid reservoir.
- Check condition of power steering reservoir. Adjust fluid level if required.
- Service power steering at manufacturers recommended interval.
- Check condition of coolant fluid and protection level. Adjust fluid level if required.
- Service coolant at manufacturers recommended interval.
- Check and fill window washer reservoir.
- Lube chassis.
- Adjust hydraulic brakes and check condition of lining. Record Brake %: Front: _____ Rear: _____
- Adjust air brakes and check condition of lining (if applicable).
Record Brake %: Front: _____ Rear: _____
- Check clutch adjustment. Adjust if required.
- Check air filter. (Note: Replacement of air filter, if needed, is not included).
- Check all lights. Replace any inoperable marker and exterior signal bulbs. (Note: Replacement of head lights is not included).
- Visually inspect batteries. Service as required.
- Lubricate external liftgate and platform fitting, if applicable.
- Check and fill liftgate oil reservoir. Check for leaks.
- Lube and inspect rear door operation. Advise of needed repairs.
- Inspect overall vehicle body. Advise of needed repairs.
- Inspect engine belts. Adjust if required. (Note: Replacement of engine belt, if needed, is not included).
- Complete Annual Federal DOT Inspection.
- Update service sticker.
